OVERVIEW

The Ministry Impact Partner is to serve Camp Lone Star by carrying out the Mission and Core Values as a member of the Program Ministry Team. This position will serve primarily in La Grange but will also assist in ministry at the Pines campus in Tomball. This seasonal position reports directly to the Program Directors and supported by the Chief Executive Officer.

- Assist in setup and takedown for guest groups utilizing camp's facilities
- Serve as a retreat host for Hosted Retreats Ministry groups
- Willing to assist and perform facility cleaning and preparation
- Responsible to assist in planning, organizing, and leading of Directed Retreat Ministry
- Responsible to assist in develop and promotion of the Summer Camp Ministry
- Assist in encouraging and walking alongside other Program Team members
- As a CLS Team member, willing to assist in any task that will further our Mission and live out our Core Values

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Minimum age 19 years old
- Dedicated Christian with a personal, growing relationship with Jesus Christ in agreement with the Camp Lone Star Statement of Faith and is willing to share their faith in Christ with others
- Desire and ability to work outdoors with children, youth, families, and adults

- Physical Demands: High physical engagement with youth and adults

SALARY AND BENEFITS

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PROGRAM SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES (65%)

- Set up (before) and tear down (after) guest groups or program groups as assigned
- Host guest retreats or day events when scheduled—includes welcoming guests, being available as a program resource or emergency contact (includes serving many weekends)
- Assist in hosting and facilitating Outdoor Education curriculum and midweek programs
- Assist in coordinating and leading monthly Family Fun Nights in La Grange
- Assist in coordinating and leading a variety of programming for our Directed Events
- Assist in the evaluation of ministry programs and make recommendations for improvements to the Program Directors and Chief Executive Officer

FACILITIES SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES (20%)

- Perform facilities cleaning and preparation on a weekly basis and as needed
- Assist the Facilities team with work projects as needed and directed

ADMINISTRATIVE SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES (10%)

- Assist the Marketing Coordinator in promotional materials and social media development and posted content to publicize our Directed and Hosted Retreat groups
- Assist in clerical support including, but not limited to, mailing assistance and document filing

OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES (5%)

- Attend approved professional training seminars and conferences
- Attend required staff meetings and devotions
- Assist in evaluating current operating procedures, making recommendations as they arise
